## **Re Mike Hancock MP CBE**

Members and supporters of our party are most disturbed that we have not even had the courtesy of an acknowledgement to our open letter to you sent by email and post on 27 April 2010. The letter sent by post was recorded delivery, and we are aware that it was received by your office.

Our letter raised very serious concerns about the payments by way of salary and expenses to Mr Hancock, and to members of his family. We provided considerable detail of the reasons for our concerns in our letter and on our website [www.jacparty.org](http://www.jacparty.org). We have also made it clear that we have full supporting documentation for what we say. We are therefore most disappointed by your total lack of response.

This is particularly so when you have said repeatedly during your campaign that your party stands for fairness and openness and is determined to clean up politics. All we have asked for is your assurance that the matters we have brought to your attention will be fully and thoroughly investigated, and that we, and all members of the public will be told the result. That means a properly audited record of all payments made to Mr Hancock, his daughter and his wife since Mr Hancock was re-elected to parliament in 1997..

Frankly we are getting the impression that you simply want to cover up what we know has been going on for years until after the election. This behaviour of Mr Hancock should have been investigated and exposed years ago, and it is disgraceful that you continue to take no action for purely electoral advantage.

As you will see from our website the Justice & Anti-Corruption Party is entirely independent, and we will criticise wrongdoing by politicians of any party. However in view of what you have said during the election campaign we would have expected your party above all others to have been properly committed to fairness and transparency.

We are again copying this letter to the leaders of the Labour and Conservative Parties, and will be providing a copy to the Parliamentary Commissioner for Standards after the election.
